To ensure that we are all complying with the terms of our Lease with the Town Council, the Membership Sub Committee has been carrying out inspections. It was a pleasure to visit fields and see plots being well cultivated and meeting members enjoying the Spring sunshine. Some members whose plots have fallen below the required standard have already been contacted. A couple of reminders - Paths to the right-hand side of the plot need to be kept tidy and safe to walk on, only items used for cultivation can be stored on the plots, trees must be kept to a maximum height of 3.5m and not overhang other plots. If you have trees that are higher than this, please arrange for them to be pruned at the appropriate time of year.

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
